<u>Christmas Triduum</u>: This year we will again have a Triduum of Masses which will be said on 30th & 31st December 2025 and 1st January 2026. The masses will be at

11am each day in Clarecastle Church. The money collected is given to the local conference of St Vincent de Paul and local charities.
