Churches Open for Private Prayer: Please abide by guidelines posted in church.

* Clarecastle church will open each day, Mon-Sun from 1pm – 4pm.

* Ballyea Church will open from 10am – 5pm.

Churches Reopening for Worship: The Roadmap to Recovery allows for the opening of churches for public worship from the end of June. We are in the stages of preparing for the opening of churches in our parish at present. The churches will have to operate in keeping with the directives of NPHET, and people will see severe restrictions in place when churches reopen for liturgical events. The parish Pastoral Councils will outline the arrangements for both churches in our parish next weekend. We advise people to be aware of the following conditions:

1. All churches will have a very reduced seating capacity.
2. During this Covid-19 crisis, the obligation to attend Sunday mass has been dispensed. People are under no obligation to attend mass.
3. People can attend mass during the week rather than at the weekends.
4. Masses can be attended by listening on the parish radio or on the webcam from home.
5. Alternatively, people can park in the car park and listen on the parish radio link or view on the webcam. They can come forward for communion at the end of mass.
6. Each person has personal responsibility for their own welfare. Each of us need to sanitise personally, and ensure we observe all the guidelines for personal safety.
7. The parish needs the help of many volunteers to clean and sanitize the church each day and also people to act as ushers. Please contact any member of the parish council to offer your services. Your help is very much needed and appreciated.
8. We thank and express our appreciation to all of you who have been so kind and supportive of the parish and parish personnel during these difficult times.
