Celebration of the Sacraments: Earlier in the school year we circulated provisional dates for the reception of the sacraments of First Penance, Communion and Confirmation for children in our parish. The provisional dates we set were in April and May. Due to the current level of health restrictions in place at the moment and due also for the need to prepare for these sacraments, it is impossible to see these sacraments been celebrated on those dates.
