Feast of St. Brigid Tuesday 1st February is the Feast of St. Brigid, who is the Secondary Patron of Ireland. She is renowned for her hospitality, almsgiving and care of the sick. Born in 454 she was determined to dedicate her life to the service of God as a religious witness. She founded a double monastery in Kildare with the assistance of Bishop Conleth. She died in 524 and her following is widespread not just in Ireland but throughout several European lands. The St. Brigid's Cross, in legend used by Brigid to explain the Christian Faith, remains a popular sign of God's protection.

Feast of the Presentation of the Lord Wednesday 2^{nd} February. This feast day traditionally known as Candlemas Day is the day when Jesus was presented in the temple and where the holy ones Simeon and Anna met him and told Mary "a sword would pierce her heart". Candles for church and home use will be blessed at the 10.00am mass on Wednesday. Please leave candles for blessing in church before that time.

Feast of St. Blaise Thursday 3^{rd} February. We celebrate the Feast of St. Blaise, a physician before becoming a bishop. Since the eight century he has been venerated as a Patron of those who suffer from throat disease.
