Mass Times for Holy Week: There will be mass Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday mornings this week at the usual time of 10am. There will be **NO** evening mass on Wednesday evening and **NO** morning masses on Thursday and Friday mornings. There will be an evening mass in Ballyea on Tuesday 12th April at 8pm for the late Mary, Christy and Jane O'Shea, Darragh.

Chrism Mass: The Chrism mass, the mass at which the bishop blesses the Holy Oils to be used in the Diocese in the celebration of the Sacraments during the coming year will be in the Cathedral Church, Ennis on **Wednesday 13th April at 7.30pm**. This year at the Chrism mass the bishop will commission the 24 lay people from across the diocese who trained in Ministries over the last four years. We are fortunate to have two of our parishioners in that group, **Bernadette Daniels**, Knocknamana and **Gerard Lynch**, Lissane. We look forward to their involvement in our parish and we wish all in the new ministries every grace and blessing in their ministry.
