Feast of St Brigid: Sunday 1st February is the Feast of St Brigid. St Brigid is the Secondary Patron of Ireland. She is renowned for her hospitality, almsgiving and care of the sick. Her dedication to the spiritual and religious life moved many to follow her example and she founded a double monastery in Co Kildare. She died in 524 and her cult is widespread not only throughout Ireland but in several European lands. The St. Brigid's Cross, in legend used by Brigid to explain the Christian faith, remains a popular sign of God's protection.

Candlemas Day: Monday next 2nd February is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord and World Day for consecrated life. We know it as Candlemas Day. It marks the celebration of the Presentation of Jesus in the temple where he was greeted by Simeon and Anna. Candles for church and home usage will be blessed at **11am** mass on Monday next. If people wish to make a donation for the purchase of candles instead of buying them, they are welcome to do so, please put the donation in an envelope of your own and mark – **CANDLES**.
